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# I. GENERAL INFORMATION

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Educational Center PRO DIDACTICA is a non–governmental, non-profit organization, founded in August 1998.

**The mission** of Educational Center PRO DIDACTICA is to promote the principles of an open society through supporting individuals and organisations interested in continuous learning and development aiming at achieving personal and professional growth, and a better integration into the society.

In order to achieve that, Pro Didactica is offering informational, training and consulting programs and services, focusing on development of life-long learning culture and skills, promotion of the values of the knowledge-based society, insurance of inclusion and equal chances for all, and supporting the European integration efforts through education.

Current portfolio of the Centre includes 22 training programs for teachers and educational managers, authorized and licensed by the Ministry of Education and the Chamber of Licensing of Republic of Moldova. The training certificates are recognized officially in the process of teacher in-service evaluation and professional advancement.

# 2. CONSOLIDATING THE VOCATIONAL EDUCATION SECTOR IN MOLDOVA

# **Objective 1. Organizational development**

Funder: International Foundation Liechtenstein Development Service

Implementation period: January 2010 - December 2010

# Total budget: 202 446 MDL

*The purpose:* Contribute to organizational development institutions 2 (College of Constructions and Vocational School No. 2 in Chisinau) involved in the project CONSEPT.

# Objectives:

- Improve management skills of administrative teams institutions included in the project
- Organize and monitor the Development plans of institutions
- Providing advice and professional expertise in the development of functional DPI

# Activities and results:

1. Organizing needs assessment visits in the institutions included in the project

In January 2010 was organized each visit to assess the needs (each two days per institution) College of Engineering and Vocational School No. 2 in Chisinau - institutions included in the CONCEPT draft in 2010. The purpose of these visits was to assess the development needs of institutions concerned, including identifying staff training needs, especially members of administrative teams. Visits were made by trainers and experts in educational management working on this project the third consecutive year: Gheorghe Şalaru, Gheorghe Gîrneţ, Valentina Chicu and Victor Sînchetru.

As a result of visits were interviewed over 110 people from both institutions and were developed lists with needs of professional development and organizational development needs.

#### 2. Workshops to prepare training activities

For the preparation and successful implementation of training activities provided to the project, 4 workshops were organized for trainers. In these workshops were discussed terms of reference and were prepared agenda and the handouts, methodology and materials for both seminar-training "Educational Management", and for both modules of the training program "DPI Development". The workshop mentioned was attended by trainers from the project mentioned Gheorghe Şalaru, Gheorghe Gîrneţ, Valentina Chicu, Victor Sînchetru, Iurie Melinte.

#### 3. Seminar-training "Educational Management"

From 9 to 12 February 2010 was implemented seminar-training "Educational Management". In this training were studied and analyzed the following topics: Change management, Education management versus General management, Educational management, Personal effectiveness etc. The program was attended by 12 members of the management team of the two institutions, including directors, vice - directors, teachers and craftsmen.





# 4. Seminar-training "Development of the Institution Development Plan"

Another training program attended by members of administrative teams was the seminar-training "Development of the School Development Plan" (modules I and II). In these two training activities that occurred during 16-19 march and 4-7 may, participated 12 managers and teachers (6 of each institution). Agenda of this activity included topics in the field of strategic management, including the development of components Development Plan, identifying and prioritizing problems, design strategy of the institution etc. Following implementation of these two training modules participants were informed about the theories of strategic management and strategic planning, and were trained to develop skills to design a functional DPI.

# 5. Development plans of the Institution

From April to September the two institutions involved in the project CONSEPT developed development plan of the institution.

# 6. Consulting Institution Development plans

From May to September 2010 the trainers involved in the project have made eight visits to the institutions concerned administrative team for consultation on Development plans. In these activities trainers monitored making documents and provided professional support working groups, which showed responsibility and perseverance in carrying out all tasks proposed, taking into account the suggestions of trainers-experts. At the end of September 2010 both institutions presented the final Development plans.

# 6. QUALITY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS IN MOLDOVA. TRAINING OF TEACHERS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MODERNIZED CURRICULUM FOR THE LYCEUM CYCLE

Course support for teacher training in the implementation of upgraded high school curriculum was developed in Romanian and Russian (for 7 academic hours ), 19 subjects, including : *Romanian language and literature (national school), Universal Literature (national school), Romanian language and literature (school speakers of other languages), Russian language and literature (school speakers of other languages), Russian language and literature (school speakers of other languages), Universal literature (school speakers of other language), Bulgarian language and literature, Ukrainian language and literature, Gagauz language and literature, foreign language 1 (English, French, German, Spanish, Italian, Turkish) Foreign language 2 (English, French, German, Spanish, Italian), History, Geography, Citizenship, mathematical Physics. Astronomy, Chemistry, Biology, Informatics, Physical Education.* 









Teacher support included the following topics: Structure and functions of the modernized curriculum (2010); Concept teaching discipline; Skills training methodology and teaching design; Linking skills undercompetences - contents - types of activities; Teaching strategies for teaching - learning – evaluation; Project unit, focused on developing pupils skills; Project as part of a lesson as an element subordinate unit operational etc.

The project results include:

- 8106 teachers trained in philosophy modernized curriculum;
- 106 local trainers trained in designing teaching the skills and involved in training areas;
- 19 national trainers and authors of educational support in disciplines;
- 19 course support for subjects modernized curriculum;
- a program of 16 hours of training of national trainers in high school in the field modernized curriculum;
- a program of 16 hours of training local trainers in high school in the field modernized curriculum;
- a training program of 7 hours for teachers in schools in the modernized curriculum.

# IV. IN-SERVICE TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAMS 2010

In 2010 Educational Center PRO DIDACTICA, on the basis of license conferred by License House of Republic of Moldova, offered training courses in adult education area, in continuous professional developing of teachers, as well as on the basis of partnerships signed with Ministry of Education from Republic of Moldova. At the end of the training, teachers obtain certificates which confirm the graduating of courses and which can be used in the process of their accreditation and assigning of educational degrees.

The Center Team is formed from co-workers, consultant-experts and teachertrainers from different educational institutions Republic of Moldova, who improved their knowledge and abilities in different educational centers from Romania, U.S.A., France, Canada, Great Britain, Belgium, Hungary, Russia, Germany, Austria and other countries.

The Center has approximately 300 m<sup>2</sup>, of space, in a central zone of the city, endowed with:

- A conference hall, alias library, were can be found more than 3000 titles of reference and didactic books in the following fields: general and educational management, pedagogy and general didactics, didactic of exact and humanist subjects, psychology, etc.;
- 5 smaller rooms for courses and group activities;
- Hi-tech outfits for training activities: retro-projectors, multimedia, flipchart blackboards, xerox, video and audio outfits, computers, printers etc.

During 2010, from the large offer program for continuous professional developing were selected the modules that corresponded to the teachers needs.

Courses took place in the CEPD, as well as in applicant institutions. The cost of a comprehensive training program was established according to the conditions required: the costs of preparing and providing training programs, materials and a coffee break.
