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I. GENERAL INFORMATION

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Educational Center PRO DIDACTICA is a non–governmental, non-profit organization, founded in August 1998.

The mission of Educational Center PRO DIDACTICA is to promote the principles of an open society through supporting individuals and organizations interested in continuous learning and development aiming at achieving personal and professional growth, and a better integration into the society.

In order to achieve that, PRO DIDACTICA is offering informational, training and consulting programs and services, focusing on development of life-long learning culture and skills, promotion of the values of the knowledge-based society, insurance of inclusion and equal chances for all, and supporting the European integration efforts through education.

Current portfolio of the Centre includes 22 training programs for teachers and educational managers, authorized and licensed by the Ministry of Education and the Chamber of Licensing of Republic of Moldova. The training certificates are recognized officially in the process of teacher in-service evaluation and professional advancement.

III. PROJECTS 2013

1. STRAIGHTENING VOCATIONAL EDUCATION IN MOLDOVA - CONSEPT

Organizational development

General objective:	to contribute to the organizational development of 9 institutions involved in the project CONSEPT.

Objectives:

- To improve the management skills of administrative staff from the institutions involved in the project
- To organize and monitor the process of elaboration of school development plans
- To provide professional counselling and expertise in the process of elaboration of several functional institutional development projects

Activities and results:

1. Workshops for preparing the trainings

Several workshops have been organized with the purpose of successful preparation and implementation of training activities. Throughout these workshops, participants have explored the terms of reference, as well as preparing the agenda and the needed materials for the trainings *Elaboration of school the development plan* and *Monitoring the implementation of School Development Plans*. The trainers engaged in the project have participated in the above mentioned seminars.

2. Training Elaborating the school development plan.

During the period from the 19th to the 20th and from the 26th to the 27th of February 2013, it has been organized the third module of the training "Elaborating the school development plan". Fifty-four managers and teachers participated (six persons from each institution involved in the project). The basic subjects of discussions were the strategic management, as well as the components of the development plan, identification and the problems settlement, a project for institutional strategies, etc. The sessions were held in an interactive way, emphasizing the managers` professional experience.

3. School development plans elaboration

During the period from March to September 2013, all the 9 institutions involved in the project CONSEPT have elaborated the School development plan.

4. Counselling in directing the elaboration of school development plans

During the period from May to September 2013, the trainers made 27 visits in the 9 institutions involved in the project, counselling the administrative staffs in the process of elaboration of school development

plans. The meetings have been organized by the management teams and assisted by the expert trainers from our centre. Furthermore, throughout the three visits, the trainers have handled counselling sessions in each institution, exploring and debating the theoretical aspects and requirements for school developing plans, suggesting useful practical recommendations, thus contributing to the completion of these important strategic documents. At the end of September, all the institutions presented the fulfilled versions of the plans for final editing and printing.

5. Visits to evaluate the implementation school development plans

In addition, during the period from November to December, several evaluating visits have been organized. The main objective was to analyze and determine the school development plan's implementation in 5 schools, participating in the 1st and the 2nd project stages: Vocational High School no.1 from Chisinau, Vocational School no.1 from Cupcini, Vocational School from Floresti, Vocational Schools no.1 and 2 from Cahul.

The expert trainers have studied and analyzed the institutional documents, such as school development plans, annual plans and annual activity reports; also, have met and discussed with the management staffs, pupils and teachers, as well as visiting classrooms and workshops. Consequently, it has been determined that school development plans were very useful to the management staff, being functional and contributing to problems identifying and settlement, even if the fixed objectives have been partially accomplished.

6. Additional annual training for managers

Resulting from the requests of management stuffs of the 14 institutions involved in the project CONSEPT, during the period from the 6th to the 8th of November, it has been held a training seminar at the educational centre PRO DIDACTICA. The basic matter of the discussions was *Monitoring and evaluating the implementation of the School Development Plan.* To point out, the institutions, which have recently elaborated school development plans, as well as experienced ones, participated in the training. On a whole, it was an exchange of experience and knowledge, guidable and practical imparting information, which led to the successful elaboration of a monitoring program of school development plan implementation.

7. Summing-up activity and Presentation of School Development Plans

On December, 24, it was organized the summing-up activity of the project. The most important achievements built up throughout the continuance of the project were reviewed, together with presentation of school development plans. Additionally, the management staffs spoke about all the challenges they passed through, which made them stronger and eager to accomplish their goals, contributing to a change in attitude and perspective.

2. CONSOLIDATING LOCAL NGOS THROUGH COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

The project was implemented under the program *Small Grants for supporting democratic initiatives* performed by the U.S.A Embassy in Moldova and provided for the period of the 1st of October 2012 to the 31st of July 2013.

Purpose: to contribute to the consolidation of local NGOs (associations of parents) by initiating community partnerships in rural areas.

Objectives :

- To persuade community of the necessity of local partnership development
- To strengthen the teams` capacity of 6 local NGOs (associations of parents) by initiating and maintaining partnerships;
- To solve some community problems in six localities, involving partners identified through educational intervention projects.

Key activities of the project:

- A workshop for introducing the project and selecting the participating teams
- A conference to launch the project and the first meeting of the team
- The seminar-training Elaborating local projects and partnership development
- Evaluation activity and certification
- Individual counselling
- Providing the resource centres with needed materials
- Activities of centre launching
- Monitoring the activity of these centres
- Summing-up activity



Six rural NGOs, such as,AO *Veghetorul*, Agronomovca, Ungheni; AOPP Unţeşti, Ungheni; AO *Paladium*, Voloviţa, Soroca; APP Ulmu, Ialoveni; AO *Speranţa*, Cuşmirca, Şoldăneşti; APP *Generaţia Nouă* Zîrneşti, Cahul, have been trained in elaborating and implementing educational intervention projects, they exchanged experiences and received a grant of U.S 1000 \$, necessary for the accomplishment of a local project in order to issue several specific problems the association of parents or the school deal with. Moreover, at the evaluation seminar, the teams, consisting of school and community managers, as well as teachers, presented and evaluated the developed projects. Furthermore, it has been accomplished the last stage of training some pedagogical aspects concerning NGOs` activity, project evaluation and the role of team activities in the process of implementing the intervention projects.

The training program for local teams was held during the period from October to December 2012; also, the local projects are going to be implemented during the period from January to May 2013. Those 24 participants have been certified, attesting to the completion of the couses of general pedagogy and the management of educational intervention project.

It is important to mention that, the questions related to supporting children from poor families have been prioritized. Of course, among project beneficiaries, were children, parents, school and community as a whole. The association of parents opened in schools a day centre for children and parents, providing it with furniture, literature, equipment and supplies, as well as other didactic materials, so necessary for leisure activities, pedagogical, psychological and social support of the beneficiaries. For sure, the impact of these

project activities is a qualitative parental participation in school life, so, avoiding the traditional financial contributions.

Also, at the end, it has been published the book *Initiatives to consolidating community partnerships*, in an edition of 400 copies, including several successful stories of the project. The book has been donated to school libraries in order to promote qualitative exchanges in initiation and maintenance the community educational partnerships.

3. ADVANCING QUALITY IN ICT VOCATIONAL EDUCATION IN THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA

Implementation period:	December 2012to May 2015

Objective: to support the qualitative improvement of the content and the process of ICT professional education in six pilot institutions (colleges and vocational schools), in this way enhancing the quality of knowledge and practical skills of the young ICT specialists. Furthermore, this will give the beneficiaries new opportunities for professional development, contributing to an increased employment and to poverty reduction.

Objectives:

- 1. The beneficiary institutions are to acquire an improved and updated curriculum for ICT specializations according to market demands, with the involvement of the representatives of ICT companies;
- 2. Improvement of ICT specialists' practical skills needed for the labour market and enrolling the trained students in private sectors;
- 3. A greater confidence of the young ICT specialists to continue their studies in IT vocational institutions.

Key activities carried out in 2013

1. Needs analysis of the beneficiary institutions and IT sector in order to optimize the project objectives and the expected results

The purpose of needs analysis was to identify the most pressing and important problems of IT education from the beneficiary institutions, as well as curriculum matter, teacher training, pupils' performances, employment rate, IT companies requirements, etc. The main tools / analysis methods included different questionnaires, focus groups and interviews. A group of sociologists, also the project teams were involved in this activity. In fact, 250 students, 25 teachers, 21 companies have participated in sociological polls, examining carefully the needs. As a result of this activity, it has been written a report on needs assessment in TVE institutions and IT field.



2. The study visit of the working group and TVE representatives to Austria

This activity was organized in partnership with the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Arts and Culture. Among the participants, there were representatives of different institutions involved in the project, as well as some of the working group. There were visited 7 relevant institutions from vocational education and ICT sector, which represent the Austrian TVE system. Needless to say that the TVE system from Moldova is much too consisting of theory and is not adjusted to the requirements of the labor market. The main objective of the visit was to collect best practices of Austrian institutions from the ICT area in order to apply the gained knowledge and experience in our institutions, to identify the particularities of the Austrian TVE system in the ICT area, especially focused attention on the curriculum development process, suitable to the requirements of the labor market, on the continuous training process of teachers from TVE institutions and on apprenticeship training programs.

3. Implementing and developing the training program for the curriculum updating team

Consequently the online announcement and to the sent motivation letter and CV, 18 specialists were selected and have been trained to update the curriculum. They participated in a training which has been facilitated by national experts, who have already developed modular curricula for vocational specialities. Moreover, during the workshops, the objectives have been settled on, as well as the training period, some unique standards of organizing the sessions and the needed materials.

4. Elaboration of curricular materials

Afterwards, 4 modules have been proposed to Informatics and Computers specialities and 12 modules for Technical Support Computer Operator from secondary vocational education.

4. THE ROLE OF EDUCATION IN BUILDING CONFIDENCE AND SOCIAL COHESION OF MULTICULTURAL SOCIETIES

The project was performed in partnership with the Centre for Educational Initiatives from Latvia and the Estonian Youth Association *Open Republic*.

Purpose: to contribute to a better social integration of ethnic minorities in the Moldovan society and to enhance the role of education in the consolidation of the multicultural society by studying the experience of other former Soviet countries and learning from their achievements and failures. **Objectives:**

- To inform of the politics and practices available in Latvia and Estonia concerning the education's role in social consolidation and cohesion inside of multicultural societies.
- To share successful educational practices to a wider public from Moldova based on the Estonian and Latvian experiences.
- To aware our citizens of the existing problems concerning social consolidation and cohesion by integrating multicultural societies.
- To work out concrete recommendations for the authorities and the general public.
- To publish several materials about the meetings and the discussions held during the study visits.

Activities:

- 1. Study visits to Estonia and Latvia by an expert group from Moldova (9-19 December 2012)
- 2. Organizing regional workshops for multicultural education from the 4th to the 8th of March 2013. The main objects are: informing of Latvian and Estonian experiences in the social integration of ethnic minorities; sharing their successful educational practices which contributed to social cohesion and to consolidating the multicultural society; to aware our citizens of the existing problems concerning integrating multicultural societies, it has been organized a group of workshops in different places of the country.
- 3. The study visit to Moldova by foreign experts and organisation of a roundtable in Chisinau (15-20 April 2013).

The purpose of this study visit by Latvian and Estonian experts was to get on with the exchange of experience between our countries, in order to take advantage of foreign practices. In order to get acquainted with the situation in our country, several meetings have been organized with various

stakeholders, representatives of the parliamentary committee for education, public administration, managers, the bashkan of GăgăuzYeri, university and school teachers.

4. The publication of materials informing of EU countries` study visits

The participants in study visits have made a number of materials, promoting and highlighting the gained experiences. Moreover, the authors proposed several practical steps to be followed to introduce the improvements to our country.

5. Organization of a roundtable to promulgate the project results by the target groups (June 26, 2013) The subject of the roundtable was *Experiences of national minorities*` integration through education. The participants were representatives of the Ministry of Education, Bureau of Interethnic relations, District Department of Education from Comrat, school managers of about 30 Russian-language schools from different parts of the country. As it was the last meeting for the project, it has been promoted the Latvian and Estonian experiences in our country. Moreover, it has been identified the target group of participants – principals of some educational institutions, where are studying different ethnic groups, as Ukrainians, Russians, Bulgarians, Gagauz, etc.

Results:

- During the study visits to EU countries, the participants have improved their abilities on building viable multicultural communities through increasing the role of educational methods and instruments.
- Moldovan experts have acquired the necessary information to promote the most advanced experiences from Latvia and Estonia, in order to improve some specific aspects in our country.
- The decision makers of our country have been informed about advanced experiences of these countries, becoming more motivated to encourage the improvement of current multicultural policies and practices.
- The civil society became more informed of Latvian and Estonian experience in the field of multicultural education.
- International experts got acquainted with actual problems concerning the multicultural space and multicultural education of our country.
- The knowledge and the abilities of various stakeholders in building viable multicultural communities have been improved, thus enhancing the role of educational measures and instruments.
- It has been set a concrete initiative of collaboration between the Educational Centre PRODIDACTICA and The youth Association Open Republic of Estonia by launching a common project to form local trainers having the job to promote language integrated learning in our schools:"Capacity Development for Content and Language Integrated Learning in Moldovan Schools via European successful models / experiences".

- to use the two modules in mentor training (methodological and practical support), offered by the international consultant for instructing 260 mentors and 40 inspectors;
- To train 260 mentors (selected from each district, based on the criteria proposed by the consultant) and 40 inspectors;
- To promote relevant instruments for the kindergartens of Moldova for monitoring and evaluating the process of teaching and learning;
- To assess the participants` acquired knowledge at district level, using the evaluation method preassessment and post-assessment;

Activities and results:

Activity 1. Meeting the project team. Tasks distribution. Results:

- A revision of the work plan and the tasks
- A general and detailed operating plan elaboration

Activity2. The 1st Workshop for national trainers Results:

- Elaboration of criteria for selecting mentors.

- The presentation of a list of 300 participants and 24 national trainers from the Ministry of Education to facilitate the participation in the program ;
- The establishment of the training program for 300 participants
- Identification of the training location and providers ;

Activity 4. The 2nd Workshop for national trainers

- Results:
- Presentation and analysis of materials. Accomplishment of materials;
- Preparation for training;
- The program of the training and the necessary materials;
- Professional skills to be developed;

Activity 5. Training program mentors Results:

- 20 national trainers involved in the implementation of the training program (292 traned mentors 15 groups)
- 20 sessions held in each period (a total of 60 sessions)

As a result, we appreciate a lot that all the activities held under the mentor training program in kindergartens were directed in accordance with the plans of the Educational Centre PRODIDACTICA and with the terms of reference formulated by the Ministry of Education. In fact, the main objective has been achieved, by offering a useful and a qualified mentor training program in early education. Under those circumstances, the didactic support needed for the training of kindergarten mentors has been updated. Moreover, it was assured the logistics for training activities and the training programs of 40 hours in 3 stages have been completed:

- I. July 15 to July 19, 2013 (5 groups)
- II. July 22 to July 26, 2013 (5 groups)
- III. July 29 to August 2, 2013 (5 groups)

The training program was organized in a professional manner; important to mention the effort and the support of international experts, national trainers and local mentors, as well as the project team. The implementation of the training program for localexperts can be considered a success; that is proved by the presence of 98% of participants, as well as the summary of reports and the evaluation questionnaires of the program.





According to the final evaluations, the activity was a very actual and useful one for the newly trained mentors. In fact, most of the participants expressed the desire to be involved in providing mentoring services. Both participants and stakeholders have mentioned the quality of the presented course, the professionalism of national trainers and teachers` interest in the treated subjects, which were quite extensive. Moreover, all the participants have been certified, as they had asked to.

In this way, the participants acknowledged the new role they are going to play, realized the differences between the traditional help offered to teachers (giving advice and recommendations) and the mentors` role (helping the teacher in finding solutions); discovered new ways of professional and personal development; proved sufficient confidence in providing mentoring services; have developed active listening abilities; created professional developing plans. Needless to say that children are the basic value which motivates to accept and to encourage the development.

V. TRAINING SERVICES 2013

The Educational Centre PRO DIDACTICA has offered programs in adult training, different courses for continuous professional development, as well as methodological instruction in collaboration and approved by the Ministry of Education through the order no 780 of July 18, 2013. At the end of the courses, the participants have been certified; to point out, those documents attest the completion of courses and can be used in the process of attestation.

The Educational Center team consists of collaborators, expert consultants, trainers from different educational institutions of the Republic of Moldova, who have improved their knowledge and abilities in different countries, as Romania, the USA, France, Canada, UK, Belgium, Hungary, Russia, Germany, Austria, etc.

PRO DIDACTICA has an area of about 300 m², situated in the center of the town and it is equipped with:

- A conference room, alias library, where can be found more than 3,000 titles in general and educational management, pedagogy, didactic of different subjects, psychology, etc.
- Five smaller rooms for trainings and group activities ;
- The latest equipment for training activities, such as: projectors, multimedia, flipchart tables, copying machines, video and audio devices, computers, printers, etc.

In 2013, from the amount of trainings, several modules that corresponded to the teachers' training needs have been chosen. Also, requests from school groups have been accepted (12-16 persons), as well as further individual registrations until the completion of the whole group (16 persons). The trainings have been held at our center, equally inside of educational institutions.

The price of the whole training has been established depending on the requests and covered, first of all, the cost of providing and preparing the training programs, then the needed materials and, finally, the coffee breaks. Each group of participants has been trained by 1-2 experts. Both the contents and the duration of courses have been established together with the participants, based on their needs and demands.

Throughout the year 2013, the training team of the Educational Center PRO DIDACTICA responded to the teachers and managers' development needs, offering a great amount of services, such as

Consequently, 800 persons have been certified.

Moreover, the enjoyable and relaxed ambiance, the trainers' professionalism, the participants' interest in the treated subjects contributed to a successful and an efficacious organization of those activities.
